

POLL WORKERS NEEDED

ELECTIONS CAN'T FUNCTION WITHOUT QUALIFIED POLL WORKERS

The Primary and General Elections are fast approaching and Greenlee County Voters will go out in full force to vote. Greenlee County has 8 polling locations. To function properly, 6 of these locations need approximately seven poll workers. Poll Workers are paid for their time.

Who is qualified to be a poll worker?

Must be at least 16 years old

Must be a U.S. Citizen

Must attend required training

Must be a Registered Voter (unless participating in student program)

The responsibilities of a poll worker are:

Assisting in setting up and taking down the polling place
Providing direct help to voters as necessary
Knowing how to properly use the voting equipment
Checking Voter Identification
Issuing voters the proper ballot
Serving all voters promptly and with specific sensitivity to voters with special needs.
