NATURE OF WORK

Under general supervision, performs work of moderate difficulty in providing health education through educational program. Performs related work as assigned.

TYPICAL DUTIES

Provides group counseling to public health program clients; assists in team teaching education classes; revises, updates and orders education materials; provides individual staff training and refinement of program education; assists in planning, implementing and evaluating special education projects; assists with community outreach efforts to extend county cardiovascular disease services; prepares media articles; maintains records and prepares reports.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Education and Experience: Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in Health Education or related field; or three (3) years of related experience; or any combination of education, training, and experience which demonstrates the ability to perform the duties of the position.

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities: Working knowledge of major nutrients, cardiovascular disease, exercise education, public health programs, and training techniques and materials applicable to health education.
