COMMUNITY NUTRITION WORKER I

NATURE OF WORK

Under supervision of the Registered Dietician learns and performs routine tasks involved in delivery of nutrition care in clinics and home settings. Performs other duties as assigned.

TYPICAL DUTIES

Develop competencies in assisting the health care team in assessing nutritional status through obtaining and recording height, weight, head circumference, hemoglobin, hematocrit, serum cholesterol, blood pressure, and other biochemical and clinical assessment. Maintains quality assurance in laboratory, anthropometry and record keeping. Compiles socioeconomic information on clientele. Certify, enroll and deliver services to eligible Women Infants and Children (WIC) clients according to established policies and procedures.

QUALIFICATIONS

Education, Training and Experience: High School graduate.

Desirable Knowledge, Abilities and Skills: Ability to learn basic nutrition principles and practices; establish and maintain effective working relationships with co-workers, other agencies, clients and the general public; maintaining accurate and concise records.
