

GREENLEE COUNTY FAIR AND RACING ASSOCIATION

SPECIFIC RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All stalls are available on assignment basis only. All horsemen must register with the Director before entering horses in stalls. If the stall is not registered to a person, the stall may be assigned to some other person. Any changing of stalls must be reported to the office immediately or you may lose your stall. Stalls are numbered.
2. There shall be no personal stalls or corrals permitted on the grounds for the purpose of confining animals without permission, including steel panels. Any unauthorized stalls or corrals will be removed at horse owner expense. **Only 1 pony horse is allowed per trainer and only if you have at least 1 race horse stalled on the fairgrounds, all others will be assessed at the same rate.**
3. No modification or adaptation of electrical systems will be permitted without approval, **including heat lamps and fans.** No appliances which draw more than five amps may be connected without specific approval. There may be an additional charge for large appliances which cause exceptional energy use. Electrical cords shall not be connected to barns or stalls without approval. There shall be no painting or marking stalls in any way, including brands, without approval. No damaged or frayed cords.
4. **There shall be no additions to stalls or surrounding area, including overhangs, privacy screen, extra shelter, panels or fencing connected to stalls.**
5. The area in and around the stalls shall be kept clean and neat for a minimum distance of 40 ft., in front of the stalls. Other garbage shall be placed in the receptacle provided. Failure to do so shall result in the cleaning being performed by our maintenance staff and the horse owner shall be billed for the additional cost of minimum rate of \$25.00 per cleaning per stall. **All stalls and surrounding area need to be kept clean at all times, stalls will be inspected.**
6. All stalls will be rented on a first come, first serve basis. Only one horse is permitted in each stall.
7. All rent shall be paid in advance. Rental fees for stalls shall be \$15.00 per horse per month or \$1.00 per day. Any unused portion of the rent shall be refunded. Fifteen (15) days use constitutes a full month=s rent. A list of those delinquent in their rental payments will be made and a copy shall be submitted to the Greenlee Co. Board of Supervisors for the appropriate legal action.
8. Race horses that are registered in the racing office are exempt from rent during the race for two (2) weeks before and two (2) weeks after race meet.
9. All tack rooms are and will be assigned on first come first serve basis according to availability. **Only 1 tackroom per 4 horses are allowed.**
10. All dogs must be on a six - foot leash at all times. The dog=s owner will be responsible for any damages or injury caused by said animal. **The animal needs to be in the presence of the owner and absolute no dog left overnight.**
11. No motorcycles or three or four wheelers ATV=s are allowed in the stall area.
12. All walkers must be set up in designated areas only. Walkers must be in good repair, or they must be removed. **No walkers will be set up without prior approval from the Director.**

13. Horsemen will provide their own bedding for stalls. All stalls must be bedded. Acceptable bedding materials shall be straw, sand, and sawdust only. **Manure must be put in designated areas only.**

14. County shall provide for the removal of dead animals 2 weeks before and 2 weeks after the race meet, **all other times there will be a \$25.00 fee accessed.**

15. Absolutely no fires are allowed on the fairgrounds, other than by the Greenlee County Racing Assoc., Maintenance staff or by special authorization.

16. Horsemen may have the use of the arena ONLY IF THE HORSE IS ATTENDED AT ALL TIMES. Horseman may also use the arena corral according to posted time only. No horse will run at random on the fairgrounds. No loose horses will be allowed in arena or side corrals without permission from Director.

17. The Greenlee County Fair & Racing Assoc., has the right to refuse any applicant or evict any user for any violation of these rules, and regulations of the Arizona revised Statues or ordinances of Greenlee County.

18. During the racing season you may have your mail sent to: Greenlee County Fair and Racing PO Box 123, Duncan, AZ 85534.

19. No personal equipment or belongings may be left in or around the stall or race track areas, except those items normally associated with training and racing. Such allowable equipment must be stored in the stall area. No privately owned or personal equipment or property may be left at the fairgrounds or race tracks after hours. If there is anything left on the premises without permission, or for a specific time it shall be stored by the Greenlee Co. Fair & Racing Assoc., and shall incur a daily storage fee of \$5.00 as an agreed charge to be billed to the owner. Items left 14 days shall be deemed abandoned, title shall vest in the Greenlee Co. Fair & Racing Assoc., and items shall be disposed of at will and pleasure of said Assoc. Any and all such items of property are left at the owners peril and under no circumstances shall Greenlee Co. Fair & Racing Assoc., be responsible for any loss or damage.

20. All horse trailers must be parked along the east backside fence. No horse trailers are to be stored in the stall or RV area at anytime.

21. Two weeks after the races the stalls that are available may be rented to persons with horses other than race horses until two weeks prior to the races the following year.

22. The Greenlee Co. Fair & Racing Assoc., reserves the right to amend or add to these rules as it may deem advisable with the approval of the Board of Supervisors. The Assoc., reserves the final and absolute right to interpret these rules and regulations and to arbitrate, settle, and determine all matters, questions, and differences in regard there to or otherwise arising out of connected with or incident to the fairgrounds.

23. A complaint by three or more individuals who are renting stalls in the immediate vicinity where animals or objects are creating a nuisance. This individual will be instructed by the Director, or Chairman of the Assoc., to remove such nuisances within 3 days. If such nuisances in not removed within 3 days period the complaint will be turned over to proper county authorities.

24. Receiving barns & corrals, test barns, & corrals are not to be used except during race meets. Unless authorized by Director.

25. The round pen in east side of the fairgrounds may be used by anyone requesting to do so, 30 minutes per use if others are waiting for use of the pen. No horse may be left unsupervised in the pen.

26. No alcoholic beverages of any kind will be allowed or brought onto fairgrounds **at anytime**, and will be asked to vacate if this is violated.

27. NO weapons or firearms are allowed on the fairgrounds at any time. If this law is violated you will immediately be asked to vacate with possible law

enforcement.

28. 30 days prior until 2 weeks after the races, the Gap will be closed to all traffic.
29. Non-profit Organizations will not be charged for space in the commercial building during the Greenlee County Fair, if no fund raising activities are taking place.
30. All Non-profit Organizations will be permitted to use any part of the fairgrounds at no charge. A refundable \$40.00 cleaning/damage deposit will be required for the use of the building.
31. There will be a \$50.00 or 10% of gate for any event that charges admission to the public, excluding Non-profit Organizations.
32. Any use of the arena must be scheduled in advance with the fair and racing Director.
33. Boarding animals in the side corrals of the arena will be assessed at the rate of \$2.00 per day or \$10.00 per week. Race horses left in the side corrals are subject to same charge.

R-V Hook-ups

1. All R-V Hook ups will be used by areas and absolute preference shall be given to persons whose profession or occupation is involved with racing horses. The preference will be given on a first come, first served basis by either reservation or request. Additional camping spaces may be authorized for exhibitors or other persons connected with an event scheduled at the Greenlee County Fairgrounds.
2. Rental fees for trailers requiring sewer hookups will be \$5.00 per day.
3. Rental fees for campers which do not require sewer connections will be \$4.00 per day.
4. All rent will be paid in advance.
5. All trailers and campers must be registered within the administration office before setting up or unloading. **Without doing so, you will be considered trespassing.**
6. All camping and living areas will be kept clean at all times.
7. **No outside large appliances are allowed without the Fair Office approval and an extra charge in the amount of \$10.00 will be assessed per appliance.**
8. **The fairgrounds staff will not provide the removal of household garbage, this is the tenants responsibility.**
9. The Greenlee County Fair and Racing Association has the right to refuse any applicant or evict any user for any violation of these rules, the rules and regulations of the Arizona Racing commission, the Arizona Revised Statutes, or the ordinances of Greenlee County.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF RACE TRACK & FAIRGROUND RULES & REGULATIONS

I have been given a copy of the race track (fairground) rules and regulations and in consideration and as a condition of the privilege for permission to camp, stall horses or the use of the facilities on the Greenlee County Fairgrounds premises for the purpose of racing, training or other organized event, I agree to all provisions set forth herein as follows:

- A. To abide by all rules pertaining to stalling and camping.
- B. To vacate the stalls and move all horses, equipment, and personnel off the premises of the fairgrounds within three (3) days after being requested to do so.
- C. That the Greenlee County Racing Commission, its agents, or employees will not be liable or responsible for any injury or loss suffered in any manner by or to the horse or horses or equipment or personnel of the undersigned, while on or off the premises or while being transported in any manner on or off the premises, whether caused by conditions of the premises, by negligence or otherwise.
- D. To hold the Greenlee County Racing Commission, its employees or agents, free and harmless from all loss, cost, damage, liability or attorney=s fees which may be asserted against it by the undersigned or by any other person or persons, whether or nor employees or agents of the undersigned, by reason of or arising out of the camping and stalling and/or action of horses of the undersigned, or by reason of any conduct or negligence of the undersigned or his employees or agents:
